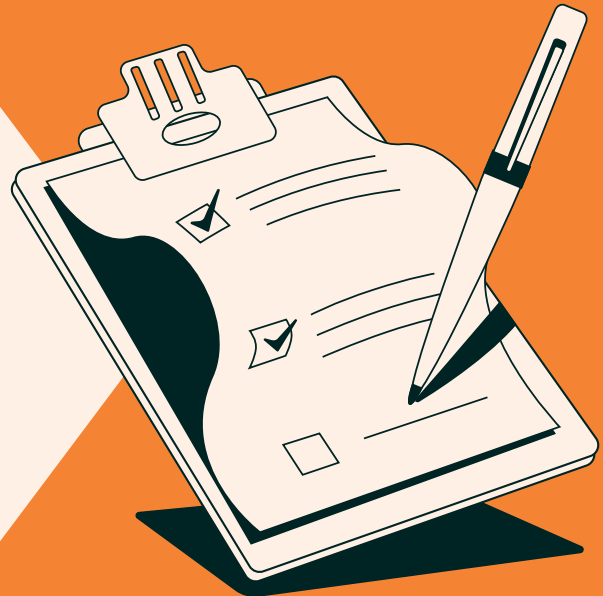

- You have 250 or more employees, or
- Your annual turnover is over £44 million, and your annual balance sheet total is over £38 million
